

Safety Guidelines

- 1.) DO NOT approach horses or horse area without authorised personnel
- 2.) Waivers/medical/Riding history forms and helmet fittings must be completed and checked before entering Horse areas / approaching horses
- 3.) Regardless of experience DO NOT approach horse without instructor's permission

DO NOT

- DO NOT approach horse without permission from authorised person
- DO NOT approach horse in kicking zones
- DO NOT yell or make loud sudden noises
- DO NOT Run or make sudden movements
- DO NOT Wrap a horse's rope or reins around any part of your body
- DO NOT Stand on lead rope or reins to hold or restrain horse
- DO NOT be complacent around horse
- DO NOT let the reins or lead rope dangle towards the ground
- DO NOT duck under the neck or body of a horse
- DO NOT Kneel or sit on the ground near a horse
- DO NOT use mobile phones whilst riding or around horse area
- DO NOT mount a horse when secured or without instructor present

DO's

- DO be Precise when giving detail to riding and medical history
- DO listen to all instruction given by authorised personnel
- DO approach a horse with its safety zones in mind

(front left-hand shoulder in horse's sight)

- DO Wait for assistance before approaching horses or horse areas
- DO wear helmets at all times around horses
- DO avoid Kicking Zones
- DO make subtle noise on approaching horse i.e. use of low tone voice so the horse is aware of your presence
- DO correctly secure horse (or have it controlled) when grooming saddling or rugging
- DO move quietly and confidently when working around a horse

Conditions of ride

All instructions from staff must be obeyed at all times

Failure to comply will result in rider being asked to dismount
